

Bringing out the best in your students: A seminar for PhD supervisors

Course description:

In conjunction with a writing workshop aimed at PhD students, we are also offering a session for supervisors. Good supervision can take many different forms, and not all students need the same kind of help. The first part of this workshop offers an opportunity to reflect on both different styles of supervision and the dilemmas that supervisors often face, including how to balance your students' needs and your own. The second part of the workshop looks specifically at giving feedback to students on their writing: discussing both the common writing problems that students face, as well as different ways of offering constructive feedback.

The workshop will include both lecture and discussion, as well as some practical exercises.
