Apply for various NFIF grant schemes!

NFIF members are encouraged to apply for funding to cover expenses connected to research stays, travel to conferences in Norway and abroad, hosting digital guest lectures and to support innovative projects. Additionally, supervisors that are active NFIF members are invited to apply for online guest lecture sponsorship and travel grants.

NOTE: Due consideration to travel restrictions connected to the COVID-19 pandemic applies to all grants.

Travel grants for students

NFIF travel grants give PhD students the opportunity to conduct national research visits and to participate in online conferences, courses and workshops in Norway and abroad.



NFIF innovation grant scheme

In line with NFIF strategic aims, the innovation scheme promotes innovation within pharmaceutical sciences and supports young research talents.

PhD students that are full members of NFIF can apply for an innovation grant to cover 1 to 2 months of salary and/or running costs.

Each student will receive an innovation mentor!

Grants for arranging NFIF courses

Supervisors can apply for up to 54,000 NOK to organize digital courses for NFIF members. If you have a relevant course and would like to apply for grants, please read the guidelines and requirements for NFIF PhD-courses.



Guest lecture grants

NFIF offers funding for inviting leading and up and coming international researchers to be guest lecturers in online events. NFIF supervisors and research groups can apply for up to 54,000 NOK for such funding.



Supervisor travel grant scheme

In accordance with NFIFs aim to promote student mobility and internalisation, the supervisor travel grant schemes aims to promote international collaboration within Excellent Education and Research. Supervisors can apply for a travel grant of up to 50 000 NOK to visit NFIF PhD students while abroad at research stays or to prepare student visits.
