

1 User guide for the uiosloforside package

This package² makes it easy to create an official front page to a research report, a master thesis or any other document published at the University of Oslo. Two examples are shown in Figure 1 on the next page.

1.1 Parameters

The package has the following parameters:

altfont specifies that an alternate font (namely, *New Century Schoolbook*) is used rather than the University's official font *Concorde*. This option is intended for those who do not have *Concorde* on their laptop or home computer.

color or colour is required when you want to specify any colours (using the `\uiosloforside` options `boxcolor=xxx` or `textcolor=xxx`).

proceedings indicates that the front page is for a proceedings of some kind. This parameter only defines the proper ISSN number; in addition, you must use the `kind` option (described on page 5) to specify the correct text.

report identifies that the front page is for a kind of report. As the `proceedings` option described above, this parameter only specifies the ISSN number.

thesis is used for PhD theses. Just like the `proceedings` option mentioned previously, this parameter just affects the ISSN number.

In addition, the package recognizes the language options **american**, **british**, **english**, **UKenglish**, **norsk** and **nynorsk**.

1.2 The `\uiosloforside` command

This command is the main one in the `uiosloforside` package: it typesets a complete front page.³ `\uiosloforside` does not need any parameters, but will recognize the following options if you want to adapt the layout:


altlogo=filename is used when you want an additional logo, for instance if you write a joint thesis with a different institution.

author={name} gives the author's name. This option is only needed if the name should appear differently from the one given by using the standard command `\author`.

If there are several authors, you should write `\and` between them (as you would when calling `\author`).

²The `uiosloforside` package replaces a previous version called `ififorside`.

³If the user has requested duplex printing by passing the `twoside` option to `\documentclass`, `\uiosloforside` will also make a blank backside.

boxcolor=colour tells which background colour to use in the text box.

To use this option you must specify the color or colour package option; see page 3.

The legal colours are shown in Tables 1 and 2 on the following page; the default choice is light grey.

date=date gives the date of the document. This option is only required when the date is different from today or the date specified by using the standard command `\date`.

dept=department indicates the department with which the author is affiliated. The default is Ifi (the Department of Informatics).

ill=filename may be used to put an illustration in the white space beside the text box.

isbn=isbn number sets the document's ISBN number (if it has such a number).

issn=issn number specifies the document's ISSN number. Some common ISSN numbers are available by using a parameter to the **uosloforside** package; see Section 1.1 on page 3.

Be aware that no ISSN number is shown unless you also give an ISBN number!

kind={document type} is used to tell **uosloforside** what kind of document this is, as in

```
kind={Master thesis} or kind={Kompendium 99}
```

logo=filename tells where to find the logo of the University of Oslo.⁴ (This option may be omitted when processing your file on a computer in the Department of Informatics.)

subtitle={subtitle} is useful when the document has a subtitle.

textcolor=colour specifies the foreground colour for the text in the text box.

The default color is black; other possible colours can be found in Tables 1 and 2 on the following page.

To use this option you must specify the color or colour package option; see page 3.

title={text} gives the title of the document. You only need this option if the title is different from what you specified using the standard command `\title`.

univ={university} shows the name of the university, in the unlikely case that this is something other than the University of Oslo.
